Renaissance is an incentive program designed to promote and recognize academic achievement and good behavior from our students. In addition to recognizing the students who meet these requirements, the program honors students and staff who distinguish themselves by performing services to the school and/or community.

Non-academic requirements for all levels: no reports of disciplinary action or teacher disapproval, all outstanding fees paid, and attendance could influence your eligibility. Students are not allowed any unexcused absences or tardies. If a student is absent, his parent must call the Attendance office ext. 1208 to let them know or they must bring a doctor's note to Mrs. Kenney in Attendance within 2 days of the absence. Extenuating circumstances will be considered and evaluated by the Renaissance Steering Committee upon written request. A student must be enrolled at Neville High School for at least 9 weeks before applying for Renaissance. The application for Renaissance must be submitted online through Google Classroom during the application period for each Renaissance assembly.

There are four categories: Gold, Black, White, and Honorary.

Gold Card members: All A's

Black Card members: All A's and B's

White Card members: At least a 3.0 GPA with no more than 1 C

Honorary Card members: At least a 2.5 GPA; no D's or F's

There are four inductions during the year. The [first induction, Wed., Sept. 22, 7:30am](#), will reflect the grades from the 4th nine weeks of the 2020-2021 school year; this will include the 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, and 12<sup>th</sup> graders of the 2021-2022 school year.

The [second induction, Wed., Nov. 17, 7:30am](#), will reflect the grades from the 1st nine weeks of the 2021-2022 school year, which will include the 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, and 12<sup>th</sup> graders. Students who earn the Gold status will be allowed to request a Core Subject and Elective Midterm Exam Exemption. Black card members will be allowed to request an Elective Midterm Exam Exemption. Midterm grades of Gold and Black Card members will be an average of the 1st and 2nd nine weeks grades. Students taking Dual Enrollment courses or Credit Recovery courses may not exempt any Midterm exams.

The [third induction, Wed., Feb. 2, 7:30am](#), will reflect the grades from the 2nd nine weeks.

The [fourth induction, Wed., April 20, 7:30am](#), will reflect grades from the 3rd nine weeks of the 2021-2022 school year. Students who earn the Gold status will be allowed to request a Core Subject and Elective Final Exam Exemption. Black card members will be allowed to request an Elective Final Exam Exemption. Final grades of Gold and Black Card members will be an average of the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> nine weeks grades. Students taking Dual Enrollment courses or Credit Recovery courses may not exempt any Final exams.

The list of approved students will be posted around the school, when the evaluation process is completed.
